

LightPath FedRAMP Position

This page answers whether LightPath requires a separate FedRAMP authorization.

1. The short answer

LightPath is a SharePoint-native intranet platform, deployed as an SPFx solution into the customer's own Microsoft 365 Government (GCC High) tenant. That tenant carries Microsoft's FedRAMP High authorization. The supporting services Privion operates run in Azure Government under Azure Government's FedRAMP High authorization. Privion stores no agency content.

2. What this means for your agency

LightPath should be assessed as a component of the agency's existing SharePoint Online system boundary through the agency's own security impact analysis, not through a separate FedRAMP authorization. Scope determination belongs to the acquiring agency; Privion provides the analysis, and the agency makes the determination.

3. Supporting facts

- Content, permissions, and user data remain in the agency tenant. Privion operates no content repository, user directory, or customer database.
- AI processing stays in Azure Government and is covered through IL5.
- Privion stores no agency content. Supporting functions do not maintain federal information on the agency's behalf.
- Privion holds Microsoft GCC High Category 2 and Category 3 ISV validation.
